153.9	R - I-8 on-ramp eastward toward Yuma. [NOTE: Cyclists required to EXIT & then re-enter I-8 at each off-ramp(3) ahead. ( <i>Evan Hewes Hwy. is just over I-8 and parallels I-8 eastward for several miles. This road is in dis-repair &amp; dangerous on a road bike.</i> )	15.8

NOTE: Route starts at the real San Diego Dog Beach and climbs eastward to the high point of Tecate Summit (mile 68). Then it's downhill time, including a 13-mile plunge to the desert floor below sea level before leveling off for the long cruise into Yuma, AZ.
